GORDON, Ms. Angela "Angie" - 47, passed away Sunday July 28, 2013 at St. Joseph Mercy Oakland Hospital. Family hour 12:30PM Monday, August 5, 2013 at Antioch Missionary Baptist Church, 218 Auburn Ave., with funeral service commencing immediately at 1:00PM. Pastor James W. Lawrence, Sr. Officiating. Interment Perry Mount Park Cemetery, 878 N. Perry St. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 12:30PM Monday. Ms. Gordon will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 268 N. Perry St., and may be viewed from 10AM-5PM Sunday.

Ms. Angela Gordon was born February 27, 1966 in Pontiac, Michigan, the daughter of Mattie Hudson and Willard Washington. Angela accepted Christ at an early age, and was baptized at Antioch Missionary Baptist Church, where she remained a member until she heared the call of God to come home. Angela graduated from Pontiac Northern High School. She served many years at St. Joseph Mercy Oakland Hospital, as a manager in the dietary department. After she became disabled, Angela still continued her service at St. Joseph's. She devoted much of her time sitting and caring for her mother, until she became ill. God felt her purpose on earth was fulfilled and he called her home to glory on July 28, 2013.
