Mr. Archie DeWain Wood (Wayne), was born February 22, 1931, in Greene County, Arkansas, to John Richard Wood and Velma Grace Wood, the youngest boy of the 14 siblings and half-siblings in the family. He married Amy Nell Marchbanks in 1951. He served in the Army Signal Corps during the Korean Conflict. After his discharge from the Army in September 1955, he and Amy settled in Pontiac, Michigan, where they raised their children. Wayne and Amy were divorced in 1970. Later in 1970, Wayne married Elsie Sue Von Lienen Duncan and moved to Auburn Hills, Michigan. Wayne retired from GM Truck & Coach June 30, 1995, with 45 years of service. After retirement, his hobbies included helping Sue take care of their doggies (including his beloved "Baby" dog), gardening, and putting up fabulous outdoor Christmas displays. His flower gardens were a marvel, and were the City of Auburn Hills Beautification Winner in 2008.

Wayne is survived by his children, Velma N. Letchworth, Anita Wood, Archie Neil Wood, Allen Wood, and Lona Wood; son-in-law, Robert (Bob) Creek; daughter-in-law, Tamra Wood; stepchildren David Duncan, Carrol Gene Duncan, and Sherri Coffell; brother, John Wesley Wood; and a host of grandchildren, great grandchildren, nieces and nephews.
