As the sun rose in Marksville, Louisiana, on November 30, 1930, Louie and Rosa Belle Morris-Castile were blessed with a loving daughter, their eleventh child, Betty Jane Castile.

At the age of 2, the family moved to Crowley, Louisiana. There she attended St. Theresa's Catholic Elementary School, and in 1948, graduated from Crowley Industrial High School. She moved to Pontiac in 1953, and later worked for General Motors until her retirement.

Affectionately known to many as "Aunt Betty" because of her humanitarian , mentoring spirit, her love of family, and zest for life. She enjoyed crocheting and quilting. She volunteered her time and energy for various church

functions, and was always available to those in need.
