Mrs. Bobbie Jean Jefferson was born November 9, 1938 in Leake County, Mississippi, the daughter of Joe and Pauline McDonald. Bobbie Jean Jefferson moved to Pontiac, Michigan in 1964. She became a member of Johnson Memorial Church of God In Christ in 1965. Bobbie was member of the Choir, Usher Board, and the President of the Prayer Warriors. On February 18, 1959 she married the love of her life, Russell Jefferson and they remained married for fifty-six years. She was employed as a custodian for the Oakland County Government, a job in which she retired from after twenty-five years of dedicated service. Bobbie was an awesome cook, she loved to sing (always ready to lead a solo) her favorite song was "Still Away, Still away Lord", pray, and just being nice to people. She enjoyed being around everyone, and everyone loved her. Bobbie also enjoyed walking around

Wisner Stadium and the Summit Place Mall. She especially loved to worship and be at her church. She took a pleasure in being around her Pastor's and helping her church as much as possible. Bobbie would travel faithfully with her husband to the church's Holy Convocation in Memphis, Tennessee, Saint Louis, Missouri and Oklahoma, serving the Lord together was their joy. No matter whose child you were she took you in and loved you as her own. Bobbie Jean loved to be a help to others, and was a very family oriented woman. She took pride in knowing everyone ate well when she cooked. She will be truly missed by everyone. Her son's truly loved her. She was the apple of their eye. They loved her with everything in them. Her great grandkids had a special kind of love for her, that could never be broken. When you're married for fifty-six years it's an unexplainable type of love. They had a TRUE LOVE that was just an inspiration to watch them around each other. Bobbie had a gift about her that changed everyone's mood in a good way, when she entered the room.

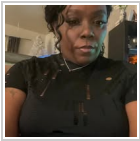
