“ I am so incredibly sorry to hear this news. Unfortunately I just learned of Brian’s passing this evening. Thank you Mike Graham for hunting me down in North Carolina to let me know. To Brian’s family, you need to know that Brian is the kind of friend that I would travel through a hurricane for. I first got introduced to Brian in high school football. Brian is one of the greatest football players to ever come out of Michigan. That includes his older brothers. I am two years older than Brian and I am the bad guy from the cross town rival, Andover. When I played against Lahser my senior year I tried to inflict as much pressure (the word I would use at 60 not 18) on them as possible. I remember a young hot shot RB that was on that team but was a freshman. We had our way with Lahser that night and I think coach K (I love you) made a big mistake not putting Brian on the field. I went off to play in college and a couple of my friends and old teammates, Mike, Greg and Allen were allowed to transfer to Lahser because we had a very bad situation at Andover. I had a great time at Boise State but my parents could not see me play so I decided to transfer. While I sat out a redshirt year, I asked Coach K (who I had a much better relationship than my own coach) if I could help coach on his team. That was one of the greatest years of my young life. I coached the LB’s (Both Mike and Greg!) so I was able to watch Brian’s incredible talent. Wow, (Brian’s family) if you did not get a chance to see him play, he was GREAT! I remember being thankful that Brian was a year too young to play against me. I had a great game against Lahser (sorry Lahser friends, just saying) but there is now way my film would have looked good chasing him up and down the field. Brian and I got pretty close that year. I have never told anyone this before but I came to the realization tonight that I Brian was instrumental in the continuation of my football career. Every time a school came to recruit Brian (and they all came) my name would come up. Brian, I and Paul Silvi all accepted scholarships to Bowling Green. Brian was an instant success at BG. He was recruited as an RB but he was SO talented that when the BG cornerbacks had a slew of injuries, they moved Brian to CB and he started the rest of the year. This was a GREAT team and Brian stepped right up and started. I know that all of you reading this know

that Brian was way more than an outstanding football player, he is an INCREDIBLE human being. If I had the chance to stand up at Brian's funeral, this is what I would have shared and also that I love Brian like a brother and will miss him dearly. May we all remember that grief is just love persisting. May our memories of Brian bless us and comfort us until we see him again. And I KNOW we will see him again. I am planning to be much faster in Heaven, Brian so please tighten your chinstrap one notch. Love you brother.
