KYLES, Mrs. Carol Ann - age 67, passed away, Monday, May 28, 2018. Family hour 10:30AM Wednesday June 6, 2018 at Macedonia Missionary Baptist Church, 512 Pearsall Ave., with funeral service commencing at 11AM. Pastor Terrance J. Gowdy, officiating. Mrs. Carol Ann Kyles was born May 3, 1951 in Pontiac, Michigan, the daughter of Richard and Beatrice Davenport. Carol accepted Christ at an early age and was baptized at New Bethel Missionary Baptist Church, under the then Pastoral Leadership of the Rev. Dr. Amos G. Johnson. She served in the SunBeam Choir, Adult Choir, Youth Department and Sunday school, as well as attending the National Baptist Congress and all Sunday School Congresses with Rev. James and Verna Eggleston. She was also active in the Liturgical Arts Ministry.

Carol attended Pontiac Schools and graduated in 1969. After high school, Carol furthered her education and attended Oakland Christian College (Rochester College) and Court Reporting School. Carol worked many years and later retired from the City of Pontiac. Upon retirement, she reentered the

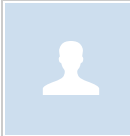
