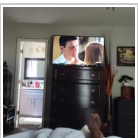

I refused because I thought that I would get into trouble for taking a ride. Aunt Frances suddenly got out the car with a switch and made me get in.... I climbed in terrified and Chico was back there cracking up 😂. He never let me live it down. I am fortunate to literally have known Chico's whole family from Texas to Michigan due to living across from Aunt Essie. Thank you for reading a few of many memories of our childhood that was filled with great joy due to his Grandmother and her Sisters, his Great Aunts and Uncles from Texas.
