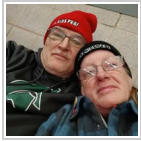

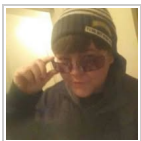
“ Chuck was like a second dad to me, I spent about as much time at his house as I did my own. You will be very missed. Love you always.

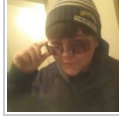
