Mr. Charlie Robinson Jr. was born February 18, 1930 in Burkville, Alabama, the son of Charlie and Hattie Thorne-Robinson Sr. Charlie married Willia Harris on July 11, 1954 in Montgomery, Alabama and later moved to Pontiac, Michigan. Charlie had several jobs which included working for Paul's Seat Covers for thirteen years until he opened his own upholstery business in 1971, "Charlie's Upholstery" in Pontiac. He operated Charlie's Upholstery for thirty three years until his retirement in 2004. Charlie and Willia were married for fifty nine years until her homegoing March 2014. Charlie accepted Jesus Christ as his Lord and Savior before his passing. He was known to his family as "Uncle Boot." He loved his family, friends and helping people in the community.
