



Deacon Moses "Mose" Thompson

March 17, 1919 - November 10, 2014

THOMPSON, Deacon Moses "Mose" - age 95, passed away, Monday, November 10, 2014 at his residence. Family hour 10:30 AM Saturday, November 15, 2014 from the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 268 N. Perry St., with the funeral service commencing immediately at 11:00 AM. Elder Gregory Thompson, Officiating. Interment Great Lakes National Cemetery, 4200 North Belford Rd. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the funeral home 10:30AM Saturday. Mr. Thompson will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home from 3:00PM-8:00PM Friday.

Deacon Moses Thompson was born March 17, 1919 in Elizabeth, Louisiana to the late Sallie Thompson and Rev. A.T. Thompson. Moses came from a family of fifteen siblings. He was asked on his 80th birthday how he remained looking so young and wrinkle free? His reply was, "Don't worry about things you cannot change." Moses loved his family very much and would do whatever he could for them. He was a proud veteran of World War II and often spoke of his experiences during the war. Often he would sit back on the sofa and reflect on his childhood during the "Great Depression," and living on the farm with his family. Upon returning from the Army, Moses Thompson came north, never to return to the south with just "\$300 - 500.00" in his pocket. He was baptized in the name of Jesus Christ and received the power of the Holy Ghost at Bethlehem Temple Clinton St. Detroit. He was later ordained a deacon. Deacon Moses worked over forty years in various ministries faithfully.

Deacon Thompson leaves to cherish his memory: children, Grace (Al), Moses Jr., Deacon Dennis (Delores), Denise, Elder Gregory, Kathy, John (Shannon), Chanitia (Darryl) Joseph, Caroline and Jeannetta; twenty six grandchildren; and a host of nieces, nephews, cousins and friends.

Deacon Thompson was preceded in death by his wife; children, Michael and Karen; parents, Sallie and Rev. A.T. Thompson.

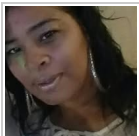
