March 30, 1950 - May 20, 2013

PEETE, Deacon Arteway George "Pete"- age 63, passed away, Monday, May 20, 2013 at St. Joseph Mercy Hospital Oakland. Family hour 10:00AM Saturday May 25, 2013 at New Bethel Missionary Baptist Church, 174 Branch St., with funeral service commencing at 11AM. Pastor Keyon S. Payton, officiating. Deacon Arteway George Peete was born to the late John William Peete Sr. and Zelner Peete on March 30, 1950 in Covington, Tennessee, the fifth of seven children. On September 30, 1972, he married Elizabeth Smith and raised five children. He was employed by General Motors and retired in 2010 with forty years of service on the Union Safety Committee.

Arteway was a caring and devoted husband, father, brother and friend who accepted Christ at an early age. His positive attitude would always bring the best out of others; if they were down, he would share his testimony of what GOD had done in his life and then follow-up with a joke or two. Peete was known for his impeccable style of clothing and his famous "Peete Ribs."
