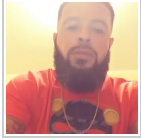

“ I met Dominick at 3 years old when me and my mom first moved to Louisiana from San Diego. He introduced himself by beating me up and breaking my toys. Lol This continued until I started fighting back and after many years (about 6 or 7) I got the upper hand for the first time and he knew I was ready. Looking back I understand that it was his way of looking out for me as a big cousin. He was making sure I could take care of myself in an environment like Louisiana. It wasn't and still isn't for the weak. But by making sure I could survive Louisiana he also made sure I could survive anywhere. I'm forever grateful to him for that. GOD gave me an angel of vengeance as a big cousin. And I wouldn't trade the times we shared for anything. I cherish every moment. I could tell story after story about our adventures growing up. We were so rambunctious and mischievous that most weekends we got put out of whichever house we were at early in the morning. We fought and broke so much that my mom or auntie Yvette would kick us out and tell us go play. Be back by the street lights. Which led to us roaming the entire city on foot or on bikes. Drinking water from random people's water hoses when thirsty. And getting into all kinds of trouble. One story that sticks out is when he and I tried to rob a grown man with karate, in one of the worst neighborhoods in the city at the time. Silly as it sounds we were dead serious. Lol the intended target knew Dominick's dad and we got our behinds tore up over it. Lot of whoopings and physical exercise. We were not just bad we were army strong lol. And one of my last memories with him was when he came to Texas to visit. I had just got released from a "vacation" and my sons mother was pregnant with him. Me, Dominick, my baby's mother and her sister went to a club on the north side and I had an altercation with some random guy and it went down. Me and Dominick ran through an entire group of Hispanics by ourselves. Dominick was a warrior. And he had a heart of gold. Couldn't have asked for a better cousin or brother. He was the closest thing I had to a brother. And I have missed him being around. So much that this is eating me up inside knowing that my last time seeing him was the last time I ever will. But I'm grateful for the memories. I cherish the fire we navigated through together making us into the men we

became. Words cannot describe the way I love you Dee. We understood one another in ways no one else could. The world has lost one of its greatest soldiers. And I know you want us to be strong and keep pushing so ima try to keep the grief brief. Watch over us soldier. Until we meet again. Love you for all eternity. -ya lil bro Durty
