Mrs. Ella Mae Green was born January 26, 1930 in Ferriday, Louisiana, the daughter of the late Monroe and Elsie Johnson. Ella married Joseph Green in July of 1947 and moved to Pontiac, Michigan in 1950, where they raised six children. They were married for almost fifty years prior to his passing in 1997. She confessed Christ at an early age and was baptized in Ferriday, Louisiana. In her earlier years she was a member of Mount Zion Missionary Baptist Church in Pontiac, Michigan. Later in life she became a visiting member of Mount Zion Temple in Clarkston, MI until she was unable to attend. In 1967, after being at home with her children, she became employed with Brae Burn Nursing Home, after twenty-five years of dedicated service she retired in March 1992.
