Perry St., and may be viewed from 2-6p.m. Saturday, February 2, 2008 and 10am to 6pm Sunday, February 3, 2008. Ernest Winslow Ott was born on June 5, 1961 in Pontiac, Michigan. He was the fourth son born to Ruth and Ernest Ott. He departed this life on Tuesday, January 29, 2008. Ernie attended Pontiac Public Schools and graduated from Pontiac Northern High School in 1979. Following high school, Ernie attended Eastern Michigan University where he was initiated in Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity Incorporated. Ernie was employed with the Oakland County Sheriff's Department for twenty three years. In his last position, he served as a Sergeant at the Frank Greenan Building.
