



## Deacon Gilbert Tremayne Hall

March 10, 1975 - February 29, 2016

HALL, Deacon Gilbert Tremayne – age 40, passed away Monday, February 29, 2016 at St. Joseph Mercy Oakland Hospital. Family hour 10:00AM Saturday March 12, 2016 from the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 268 N. Perry St., with funeral service commencing at 11:00AM. Elder Reginald Day, Officiating. Interment Perry Mount Park Cemetery, 878 N. Deacon Gilbert Tremayne Hall affectionately known as “Mayne” was born March 10, 1975 to the union of the late Gilbert Earl Hall and Pearlene Moore in Detroit, Michigan. Mayne attended Pontiac Northern High School where he was a member of the football team and played the Tenor Saxophone. Mayne later attended Oakland Community College his field of study was Criminal Justice. He accepted Christ at an early age and was member of Hopewell Baptist Church in Pontiac, Michigan. He later joined Apostolic Church of God in Detroit, Michigan, where he was member of the Deacon Board. Mayne was joined in holy matrimony to the love of his life, YeKisha Hall on August 20, 2000 (for fifteen years). To this union were born three children, Amandah (12), Ashleigh (10) and Aaron (7 Months). Mayne was an employee of St. Joseph Mercy Hospital for fourteen years. He was a security officer, who took pride in his work and always gave 110%. Mayne also loved RC cars, boats and

helicopters and had a mini collection of which he was very proud of. Mayne was very family oriented and enjoyed family game nights on the Wii with his wife and children.

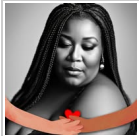
