Ida and I met for the first time on Monday, 9 Sept 1968, the first day of classes at Oakland University, and for both of us our first day on the job, she as secretary to the Area Studies Program and I as a new faculty member. In 1976 that program became the Center for International Programs and I was appointed its Director, and for the next 24 years Ida and I made that program shine. Small but significant, efficient, innovative, and student-friendly. She was its heartbeat who kept everthing and everyone in order, includidng me, correcting my spelling in memos and reports ("accommodate" has two c's and two m's), gently pushing me with a smile if I fell behind with planning or reminding me to follow up calls, and all those sorts of things (large and small) that kept the program going. And in all of it, she was professional, super competent, a charmer, and very patient with clueless students, faculty, and even administrators! She was respected and appreciated as one of the most competent, distinguished secretaries at OU who helped others in that position with advice and wisdom. Everyone loved her. Full stop! She refused to allow me to refer to her as my "assistant," as was the trendy term in the 90s; she was proudly a secretary, in the fullest and vital sense of the word. When I retired from OU in 2005 and moved to LA, she and I kept in touch especially around our birthdays. I share in the sadness and sense of loss her wonderful, dear family is experiencing. And I offer my most profound, heart-felt condolences As we all know, she is, of course, in a better place . . . and I wouldn't be surprised if she's up there helping St. Peter keeping his books straight! (Sorry for being long-winded, dearest Ida!)
