Our beloved husband and father, Isaiah Wynne Lidell (AKA I. W. Travers), went to be with the Lord on Monday, March 24, 2014, after a long illness. Isaiah was born in Alliance, Ohio on July 29, 1924 and came to Pontiac, Michigan with his mother and stepfather soon after he was born. He served in the United States Army during WWII but he was most proud of his service in the Civilian Conservation Corp ("CC Camp", his words) where he learned many skills and developed a strong work ethic, both of which he passed on to his sons.

Mr. Lidell retired from Pontiac Motors, Plant 8 where he was employed for 38 years retiring in 1976. Isaiah served as an usher at St. John United Methodist Church while under the pastorate of Rev. Andrew Allie and Rev. Frederick B. Moore, Sr.

Isaiah was predeceased by his parents, Mother, Mildred Travers and Step-Father Travers, and his loving and very attentive daughter Andrea Lidell. He is survived by his loving and faithful wife of 66 years, Mary Louise Lidell, and sons, Raymond Lidell (Cynthia), and Virgil (Rita). Both sons are retired Air Force, living in Hampton, VA. A daughter Marianne Lidell, and an "adopted" son, Cleveland Tademy Jr., both of Pontiac also survive. Mr. Lidell is also survived by grandchildren Deandra Lidell of Pontiac; Raymond Lidell II, of Texas; Brittany Lidell of Virginia; and Virgil Lidell Jr. of England.
