DAVIS, Mr. James Alfred "Barbados" - age 78, passed away, Monday, January 6, 2014 at St. John Hospital Macomb. Family hour 10:30AM Saturday, January 18, 2014 from the Chapel of Lawrence E. James Alfred Davis was born on March 26, 1935 in Saint Michael, Barbados the son of the late Tryphena Davis and John T. Braithwaite. Mr. Davis made his transition at the age of 78 years old into Eternal life to be with his Lord on January 6, 2014. Mr. Davis accepted Christ at an early age, he found comfort and worshiped at the "Prayer Temple of Love Cathedral" in Highland Park, MI where he faithfully served on the Deacon Board for over 30 years. He received his formal education in Barbados. Leaving for America in the early 60's in pursuit of the American Dream, James proclaimed his American Citizenship and made Michigan his home where he was employed for General Motors for 34 years. He wanted to enrich his quality of life. He retired in 1999. James cherished his children, grandchildren and his Barbados heritage reflecting on countless proud memories to anyone that would listen. While

reminiscing with the family, He NEVER forgot a Birthday or Holiday and would often provide memorable gifts. James was known as “Barbados” or “Jimmy” in the community. In his leisure time, he would frequently be found at “Fino’s” in the company of many special friends. He took great pleasure of mastering and playing Domino’s. James was also a member of the Jamaican Association of Michigan (JAM).
