Later on after high school, James enlisted in the United States Marines in the year of 1972 and was honorably discharged. In the year 1976, he was employed by Fisher Body-GM until he was in a very bad motorcycle accident. James lost his arm in the accident, but he never let that slow him down. One of his favorite saying was "This is James Malcolm Magee the Bumble Bee". He will be missed.
