He then went on to attend Oakland Community College. He worked at DANA Corporation until he became self-employed in the home improvement field. 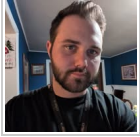

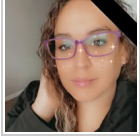

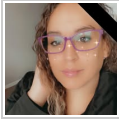
