CAMERON, Mr. Joe Frank - age 87, passed away, Friday, January 6, 2017 at Woodward Hills Nursing Center. Mr. Joe Frank Cameron was born September 21, 1929 in Eldorado, Arkansas the son of Proctor Cameron and Lula Buckner. Joe Frank gave his life to Christ as an early age. He met the love of his life, Margie Ann Cobb in 1952. They soon married on June 29, 1952 and to this union was born five children. He was hired into General Motors in September 1952, where he worked for forty-three years and retired in 1994. Joe enjoyed spending time with his family, working in the yard, fishing, playing cards and dominos. He also enjoyed being outside, listening to the blues, watching classic westerns and cowboy movies. He had a thing with getting up early Saturday mornings and preparing his Sunday dinner. He was known for his “candied yams” and “collard greens.”

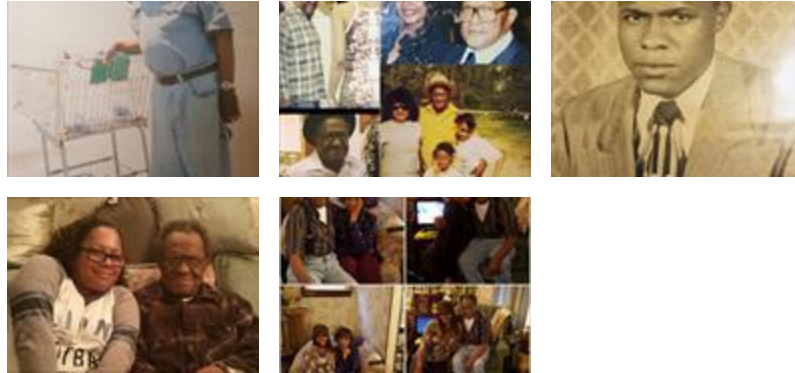
