Mr. John "Lil John" McKnight-Lewis was born December 1, 1975 in Pontiac, Michigan, the son of John McKnight, Sr and the late Carolyn Lewis. At the age of 2, Delphine, his grandmother, became his guardian and raised him as her own son and he respected and treated her as his mother. At an early age, John accepted Christ and was baptized by Rev. Clifford Chatmon at Christ Church House of Prayer in Pontiac, MI, where he was a faithful member of the choir and youth ministry. He also attended Pontiac Schools from kindergarten through high school. John was a very friendly person with a great sense of humor and generous heart.
