JAMES, III Rev. John Walter - age 56, passed away, Sunday, January 15, 2017 at Ball Memorial Hospital of Muncie Indiana. Family hour 10:00AM Friday January 20, 2017 at Welcome Missionary Baptist Church, 143 Oneida St., with funeral service commencing immediately at 11AM. Pastor Jeffrey Brown Sr., officiating. Rev. Douglas P. Jones, Host Pastor. Interment Perry Mount Park Cemetery, 878 N. Perry St. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10:00AM Friday. Rev James will lie in state at Welcome Missionary Baptist Church, and may be viewed from 10AM-11AM Friday.

Reverend John Walter James III known as “Lil John” by his family was born to John Walter James Jr. and the late Irene James on July 5th, 1960 in Pontiac Michigan. God opened Heaven’s door for John to be with him on January 15th 2017. He confessed his belief in Christ at an early age while attending New Hope Missionary Baptist Church in Pontiac MI. Over the past 30 years John attended Calvary Baptist Church in Muncie IN. In 2013 John answered God’s call into The Gospel Ministry and committed himself to faithful study and service. In 2014 John received a Certificate of License certifying him as Reverend John W. James III from Calvary Baptist Church.

Lil John always had a love for basketball from an early age. He attended Pontiac Northern High School where he formed life long relationship with friends but as John would say “his boys”. John’s basketball skills continued to

excel and earned him a scholarship at Ball State University in Muncie IN. After graduating and receiving a Master's Degree in Industrial Technology from Ball State University, John accepted a manager's position at Borg Warner. John was employed with Borg Warner for over twenty three years. Over the past three years John has been working at Mursix in Muncie IN.

Lil John was a faithful father, honorable man and a mentor-hero to many. Everyone loved John and our lives will never be the same without him. John touched so many lives during his lifetime; he was President of the Men's Ministry at Calvary Baptist Church, a Sunday School Teacher, Basketball Coach for his son King's team, and an Alumni at Ball State University.

In 1988, John married his high school sweetheart Karen Annette Bryant. To this union was born two sons, John Walter IV and King Jay'Ron James of Muncie IN; father, Deacon John James II of Muncie, IN; four siblings, Mary Frances (Larry) James-Campbell of Columbus, OH; Kurt James of Charleston, SC; Jeffrey (Michele) James of Hampton, GA; and Kevin (Shannon) James of Grand Blanc, MI; two brothers-in-law, Earnest and Termaine Bryant; two sisters-in-law, Amy and Bay Bryant; along with a host of aunts, uncle, nieces, nephews, cousins and friends.

John was preceded in death by his mother, Irene James; aunt, Lonnie Richards; uncles, Cecil Brown Sr. and Robert Brown.

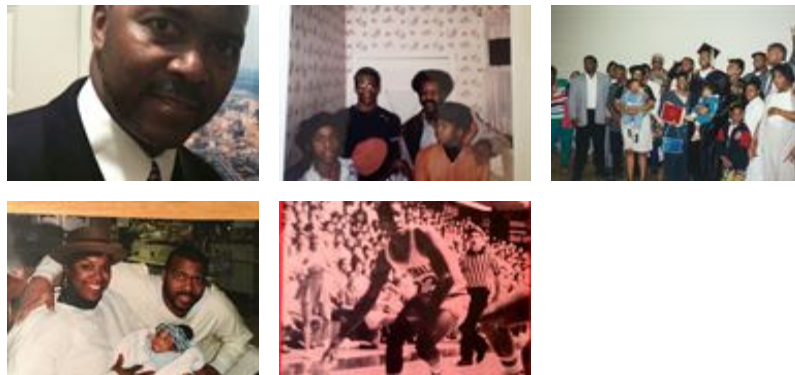

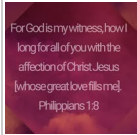

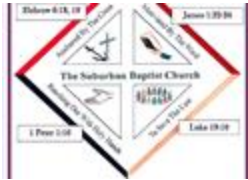
