Kevin James McClellan was born in Pontiac, Michigan the son of Janice McClellan and the late James Edward McClellan. His close childhood friends knew him as 'Slay'. 

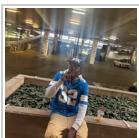
