MANNING-WOODS, Pastor Lorine - age 66, passed away, Tuesday, November 5, 2013 at Kindred Hospital Detroit. Family hour 10:30AM Tuesday, November 12, 2013 at Greater Bibleway Apostolic Church, 1180 N. Perry St., with funeral service commencing immediately at 11AM. Pastor Wilbert Reed, officiating. Elder James E. Manns Host Pastor. Interment Great Lakes National Cemetery, 4200 N. Pastor Lorine Manning-Woods was born May 1, 1947 in Haynes, Arkansas, the daughter of the late Lula Walker and Leroy Harris Manning. She was united in holy matrimony on July 13, 1991 to Mr. James E. Woods. Pastor Woods accepted Christ, April 1991 at Holy Cross Apostolic Jesus Only Church, under Pastor Lunia Womble. She attended New Hope Bible Institute and Aneon Bible College, a member of Pentecostal Assembly of the World (PAW) and became the Pastor of Holy Cross Apostolic Jesus Only Church on September 1996. Pastor Woods worked diligently in her community of Pontiac, Michigan serving as visiting clergy at St. Joseph Mercy Hospital, a Foster Grandparent with Oakland Family Services. Pastor Woods was very outgoing and loved to travel with her husband James Woods and spend time with her daughter, step daughters and all her grandchildren and great
