BRADSHAW-HILLIE, Mrs. Lynette Norine - age 59, passed away Tuesday November 3, 2015 at William Beaumont Hospital - Royal Oak. Family hour 10:30 AM Saturday, November 14, 2015 at Monument of Faith Missionary Baptist Church, 378 Auburn Avenue, with funeral service commencing immediately at 11:00 AM. Pastor James H. Keys, Sr., Officiating. Interment Perry Mount Park Cemetery, 878 N. Perry Street. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10:30 AM Saturday. Mrs. Bradshaw-Hillie will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 268 N. Perry St., and may be viewed from Noon - 8:00PM Friday.

Mrs. Lynette "Norine" Bradshaw-Hillie was born December 15, 1955 in Lima, Ohio to Audrey Ella (Watson) Evans. She went to be with her Savior and Lord from William Beaumont Hospital Royal Oak on November 3, 2015 at 3:30 p.m. "Norine" as she was known graduated from Pontiac Northern High School in 1974 and later went to Oakland University. She started her employment with the Pontiac School District and had several promotions during her 36 years of service. Norine later worked at Pontiac High School where she loved her "kids". She would always speak her mind, but always in love. Norine was taught to love God and have a relationship with Him and at 8 years old she accepted Jesus Christ as Her Lord and Savior and was baptized at New Bethel Missionary Baptist Church in Pontiac, MI under the leadership of Dr. Amos G. Johnson. In the late 1960's she later joined Trinity Missionary Baptist

Church in Pontiac, MI under the leadership of Rev. Lee Gragg, then later Dr. Robert E. Bailey. She served in ministry while at Trinity by singing in the choir as a first soprano and also the Children's Usher Ministry. In the summer of 2005 she united with the Monument of Faith Missionary Baptist Church in Pontiac, MI under the leadership of Rev. James H. Keys, Sr. She again knew the importance of being a part of the ministries of the church and she joined the anointed Monument of Faith Music Ministry and the Women's Ministry. Norine's greatest joy was she became a grandmother to her first granddaughter whom she loved, named Taylor.
