RUCKS, Mrs. Martha "Jean" - age 85, passed away, Tuesday, July 23, 2013 at her residence. Mrs. Martha Jean Rucks was born August 26, 1927 in Nashville, Tennessee, the daughter of Aaron and Josie Taylor. Martha was educated in the Nashville Public School System. She then continued her education and received her Bachelor's Degree in Education, which led her to Georgia where she was a school teacher for three years. On December 24, 1950, "Jean" entered into Holy Matrimony with Albert Rucks and they moved to Pontiac, Michigan in 1951. Jean was an accomplished piano player and an all-around athlete. She played Softball and Golf, but more commonly known to most was one of the top bowlers in Pontiac for decades until retiring due to shoulder problems. She unconditionally loved her family, those close and afar, especially her grandchildren, and great grandchildren, Zariyah Walker and Kyeme Goode whom she doted on always. Most of all she loved the Lord, and after being baptized into the Body of Christ and was a long and faithful member of the

Franklin Road Church of Christ, and in October 2004 during their annual “Ladies Day Program,” was awarded “The Virtuous Woman of the Year.” She “faithfully” attended worship service and numerous bible classes, being an active participant until her health declined to where she could not attend. She had the most infectious smile, loving personality and touched the hearts of everyone who met and knew her. She became a “relative” to all who knew her, simply being called “Aunt Jean.”

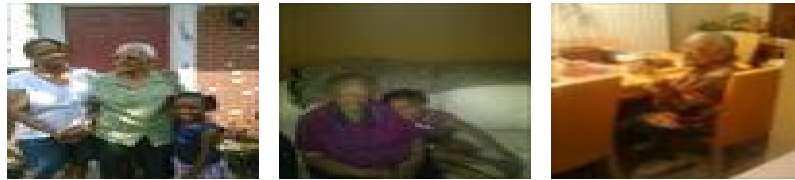
