He preceded her in death on April 8, 1996. Mary accepted Christ and received training in holiness under the late Pastorate of Bishop C.J. Johnson. She was called to serve as the secretary for Y.P.W.W. (Young People Willing Workers) and later as Chairlady. She also served as Sunday school secretary for the late Bro.
