



## Moses "Dirty Red" Simpson, Sr.

Deacon Moses Simpson Sr. was born to Frank and Mary Simpson July 4, 1935 in Montgomery, Alabama. He departed this life on August 10, 2016. Moses married Catherine Taylor in 1951. To this union seven children were born; Katherine, Patricia, Bobby, Greg, Timmie, Darryl and Moses Jr. In 1954 he moved to Pontiac, Michigan and worked at General Motors for 37 years as a Skilled Tradesman. 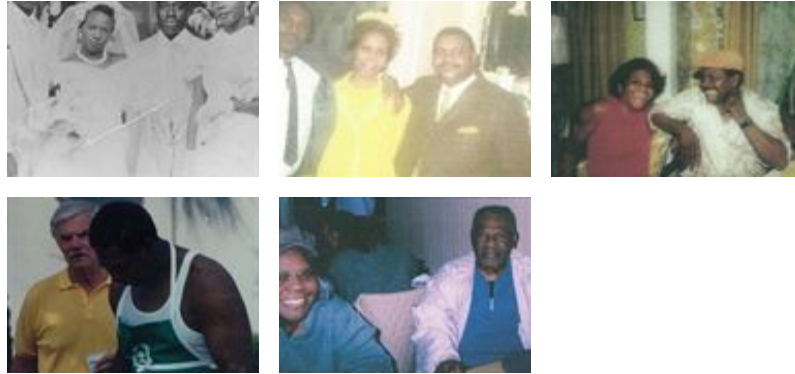
