BUCKHAULTER, Mr. Paul - Age 68, passed away Friday, November 9, 2007 at William Beaumont Hospital in Royal Oak, Michigan. Funeral service 12:00p.m. Friday, November 16, 2007 at Macedonia Missionary Baptist Church, 512 Pearsall St., Pastor Terrance Gowdy, officiating. Interment Jerusalem Missionary Baptist Church Cemetery, Brandon, Mississippi. Friends will assemble at the church 12:00p.m. Friday. Mr. Buckhaultler will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 268 N. Perry St., and may be viewed from 12 to 8p.m. Thursday. Paul Dean Buckhaultler was born on February 24, 1939, to the late Dan and Juanita (Harper) Buckhaultler. He and his ten siblings were raised in Braxton, Mississippi. He accepted Christ at an early age and united with Jerusalem Missionary Baptist Church in Brandon, Mississippi. He later attended New Hope High School. After graduation from Jackson State University, where he pledged Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity, Inc., he accepted a teaching position with the Pontiac School District in Pontiac, Michigan. He went on to earn a Masters of Education degree from Wayne State University where he graduated Phi Beta Kappa. In addition, Paul earned a Specialist degree in School Administration and several certificates. He married Nenner (Steverson) Buckhaultler on August 2, 1964, and they had two awesome daughters, Paula and Kassandra. He taught for 41 years with the Pontiac School District before retiring in 2004. Paul was a faithful member of Macedonia Missionary Baptist Church. He was an avid bowler and enjoyed participating in local leagues and traveling to

tournaments. Other hobbies included woodworking, coaching, attending sporting events and spending time with family. He was a known chauffeur, chaperone, and all-around assistant to his wife with activities in and out of the classroom that she organized. Paul leaves a loving and devoted wife of 43 years, Nenner S. Buckhaultler; two daughters, Paula Buckhaultler of Indianapolis, Indiana, and Kassandra Buckhaultler of Addison, Illinois, and father-in-law, Reverend Bunnard Steverson. He is survived by eight siblings; Gladys Pope of Utica, Mississippi; Murdock Buckhaultler of Las Vegas, Nevada; Ella P.
