



## Rev. Wilbert "W.T." Alexander

May 17, 1941 - August 10, 2014

ALEXANDER, Rev. Wilbert "W.T." - age 73, passed away, Sunday, August 10, 2014 at St. Joseph Mercy Hospital Oakland. Family hour 10:30AM Saturday August 16, 2014 at Providence Missionary Baptist Church, 299 Bagley St., with funeral service commencing immediately at 11:00AM. Pastor Terrance Garrett, officiating. Pastor Robert Martin, Host Pastor. Interment Perry Mount Park Cemetery, 878 N. Perry St. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10:30AM Saturday. Rev. Alexander will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 268 N. Perry St., and may be viewed from 3-8PM Friday. The family will be present to receive friends from 6PM-8PM, at the funeral home on Friday.

Rev. Wilbert T. Alexander was born May 17, 1941, in Cory, Louisiana, to the late David and Alice Alexander. To this union ten children were born. Wilbert received his honorable discharge from the military in 1964. Shortly thereafter, he gained employment at Pontiac Motors for a short period of time. Wilbert then took a educational leave and began his career in real estate. He soon became a licensed broker/owner and licensed builder for forty-one years.

Wilbert's accomplishments didn't end there he was certified in electricity and was a volunteer deputy for the Oakland County Sheriff. Wilbert furthered his education at Birmingham Bible Institute and the S.J. Williams School of Theology. He was also a member of the International F and Am Masonic

Order and the Order of the Eastern Star. Wilbert also just received his Associate Degree in April 2014. Wilbert accepted his calling to preach in 1991. He served as a Associate Minister at Hopewell Missionary Baptist Church in Pontiac.
