He was educated in the West Virginia Public School System As a child he accepted Christ as his personal savior and was baptized at Macedonia Baptist Church in Ethel, West Virginia. There he met and married his late wife Annie Pearl Thomas. From this marriage two children were born, Felecia Letia and Charles Antonio Williams. Mr. Williams joined the United States Army November 29, 1961. During his tour of duty he served three terms in the Vietnam receiving three purple hearts and the Presidents Medal of Honor. Upon being honorably discharged from duty he relocated to Pontiac, Michigan where he met and married his present wife Mauretha. He was employed at Pontiac Motors for thirty years. R.C. as he was fondly called by all whom knew him. RC had many hobbies, he was an avid bowler, a master mechanic, he drove eighteen wheeler trucks, tour buses, a chef and a great fisherman.
