There are men who cut hair, and then there are barbers—real barbers—who build something greater than a business. They build a legacy. Willie "Mr. Willie" Rowls Jr. was that kind of man. He was more than a barber; he was a pillar, a mentor, I knew him as a storyteller, and a guardian of tradition. His shop at 545 E Pike St. wasn't just a place for a fresh cut—it was a place where people gathered, where wisdom was shared, and where the next generation learned the value of hard work, respect, and pride.

Mr. Willie had a way of making everyone feel welcome. He opened his doors to me, allowing me to share knowledge on Black History, Privacy, and Security, Know Your Rights, and even giving me the space to play Jazz Guitar. Despite the size of the barber shop, my brother and I once performed a full guitar jazz performance there for customers. That speaks volumes about the kind of man Mr. Willie was—one who believed in the power of education, the importance of history, and the healing power of music. He understood that a barber shop is more than a service; it's a sanctuary for the community.

His laughter, his presence, and his commitment to the people of Pontiac will be missed, but his impact will never fade. The memories made in that shop, the lessons taught in that chair, and the bonds formed in that space will carry on.

Rest well, Mr. Willie. You were and remains a legend in every sense of the word.
